

With the generous support of the Eastern Health Foundation, Leadership Victoria is pleased to be able to offer a scholarship for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples in the 2024 Williamson Leadership Community Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must:

- identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- be an established or high potential leader
- demonstrate how your Williamson experience will shape your community participation

Williamson fees are structured so that there is an organisational and an individual component. The standard organisational component will be covered by the scholarship. Successful applicants will be expected to contribute the individual financial component.

Selected candidates will be expected to participate in a range of communications activities connected with this scholarship including, but not limited to:

- newsletter and magazine articles
- social media posts
- website stories
- potential media opportunities.

Additionally, they are required to contribute to scholarship progress reporting. Scholarships are not transferable.

The successful applicant will be asked to commit to full attendance and participation in the program. Applicants should carefully consider the time commitment before applying – a successful applicant who finds they are unable to meet the requirements must forgo the scholarship.
